Class Descriptions

Debate Team: Think you are right all of the time? Prove it! Join our Award-Winning Debate Team where students work in small groups to perfect the art of public speaking, listening to your opponent, researching your topic, expanding your vocabulary, in an effort to prove their point. Every month students will compete in tournaments across New York City.

Creative Writing: Students will generate ideas and practice editing and revising original pieces to create finished poems and stories. Students will free-write every day, respond to prompts and look closely at how established writers craft their work. Students will write their own pieces, self-publishing them at the end of the trimester.

French Club - In this introductory course, students will learn the basics of French grammar and vocabulary. Students will learn how to read basic French writing and pronounce French words to engage in basic conversations.

Chess/Strategy Gaming: Open to all levels. This engaging activity introduces planning, action/reaction, spatial relations, strategy and sportsmanship and is a workout for the mind as well as a competitive outlet for intellectually curious students. Students will be paired with players of similar experience as they learn fundamentals, explore the game's complexities and prepare for serious competition.

Dungeons and Dragons: Dungeons and dragons is a cooperative storytelling game in which players assume the roles of heroes, or Player Characters (PCs), undergoing an adventure. The players decide how their characters will react to different situations by rolling dice

Online Gaming / Game Space: Students enrolled in game space/ Online gaming will enjoy a variety of activities.

Silent Study Lab: Students will have the opportunity to complete their homework in silence with the help of CS teachers and trained teaching assistants. Students must do homework in this activity or read a book.

Re-Fresh Friday: Join us each Friday as we relax and unwind. Students will enjoy watching movies, going to the park or otherwise while relaxing and listening to music.

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Songwriting/Guitar: Are you interested in creating your own songs! Would you like to take your vision from concept to a finished project? Participants will explore various aspects of songwriting including creating beats, original dynamic rhythms, pitch, tone, timber and orchestration. Using a variety of acoustic instruments and digital audio workstations, students will collaborate to generate and produce an original composition. Students will upload their original projects to a service similar to Vimeo to share with family and friends.

Percussion- Each Session is for both Beginners and Advanced -Join us as we continue our percussion program, practice rhythms and tempos with snare, bass and top hats.

Piano: Students will learn the basics of music theory as it relates to the piano. Students may develop and write music for the piano in collaboration with teaching artists and peers.

Musical Theatre: Preparing for the winter musical. Students will be part of a comprehensive theatre program that includes acting classes, choreography, and scene study. Students will work with professional theatre teachers to create vivid and inspiring performances. Roles will be auditioned and assigned during rehearsals. Fall and winter trimester commitment mandatory.

Technical Theatre: Preparing for a future in theatre production? Students will be part of a comprehensive technical theater working with professional theater teachers to create vivid and inspiring performances.

CS VOICES - a fun place where students will enjoy the art of singing. This class is designed to let students have fun like karaoke but in school :)

Digital Music Production: Students learn to use music software and technology to understand music theory, composition and production, producing their own collaborative album. Possible events may include trips to music studios and production facilities.

TRUE BEATZ: An adventure through music! Students will explore various styles and genres of music to encourage students to perform, analyze, and appreciate Music. Explore music from various time periods and cultures. Young learners will enjoy interactive lessons that challenge students while gaining knowledge of different styles of music, from hip-hop to the blues to latin rock, etc.

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Cross Country: Through training and conditioning with Computer School coaches, students will work on their stamina, flexibility, agility and overall fitness. Students will participate in various activities outside, and will often run to nearby parks and fields.

Flag Football: This program provides young players a fun and exciting opportunity to engage in non-contact, continuous action while learning lessons in teamwork. Designed to educate young people about flag football while emphasizing participation and sportsmanship. Players learn skills and lessons that help them succeed both on and off the field. Tryouts are required and only those students who are accepted will join the team. **TRYOUT REQUIRED.**

Boys/Girls Soccer: Fast paced and competitive. Our championship team is a great way to get physical. Soccer will teach you about Leadership, strategy, fitness and teamwork. Tryouts are required and only those students who are accepted will join the team. **TRYOUT REQUIRED.**

Girls Volleyball: Fast paced and competitive- Welcoming back our CS volleyball team! this team is a great way to get physical. Volleyball will teach you about Leadership, strategy, fitness and team work. Tryouts are required and only those students who are accepted will join the team. **TRYOUT REQUIRED**

Table Tennis: NON-COMPETITIVE - This fall we are offering two sessions of Table Tennis. Students are only permitted to sign up for one session per week. Please do not register for two sessions of table tennis. Working to a competitive season in the winter.

In School Fitness: Are you interested in being active but don't want to have to commit to a set team? We have a place for you. Join us! We will participate in various physical activities around the school!

Geocaching- An outdoor recreational activity, in which participants use a (GPS) receiver or mobile device and other navigational techniques to hide and seek containers, called "caches", at specific locations marked by coordinates all over the world. Students will work on a circuit primarily in Central Park.

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Portfolio Art: Varies by Trimester- Students develop comprehensive art portfolios helping them to prepare for the admissions process into highly competitive art schools throughout NYC. Trimester classes may include drawing, painting, Acrylic, sculpture, ceramics, and digital design.

Anime Club: Anime club meets to discuss, show, and promote anime and can also focus on broadening the understanding of different cultures.

Studio Art: Students develop skills in the development of visual art Trimester classes may include drawing, painting, Acrylic, sculpture, ceramics, and digital design..

Jewelry Making- Students will learn the basic to advanced skills of making jewelry using common materials, study the history of jewelry making and how it has influenced fashion, culture and society.

Urban Photography: Have fun preserving all of the great memories of the school year! Students will design, create, and publish a photobook for the school community.

Yearbook: Students will design, create and edit the school yearbook, collecting photos and preparing written pieces for the issue. Students will document school and news events that marked the school year.
